BUT I STILL SIN????

As we shared in article GE-3, God has never changed His plan of salvation since He offered salvation to Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden. God's plan of salvation has always been the same.

It is important to note, however, that at the moment of salvation, it is the spiritual body (the inner body) that is restored back to fellowship with God, not the material body. Our material bodies have an old sin nature and they will never lose it. That is why our material body will never get out of this world alive. Our material body has never wanted to do the will of God in the past, our material body does not want to do the will of God now and our material body will never want to do the will of God in the future.

Paul said in his letter to the church at Rome, “22. *For I am delighted with the law of God according to the inner man, 23. but I see another law in my members warring against the law of my mind and making me prisoner to the law of sin that is in my members. 24. Unhappy man that I am! Who will deliver me from the body of this death? 25. The grace of God, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Therefore I myself with my mind serve the law of God, but with my flesh the law of sin. Romans 7:22-25 Confraternity–Douay Version (Saint Joseph New Catholic Edition).*

That’s the reason Paul said in 2nd Corinthians 5:1-10 that God will give the spiritual bodies that have been restored back to fellowship with Him through salvation a heavenly, glorified body at the catching up or the Rapture (1st Corinthians 15:35-58).
