IS THERE HOPE?

In our last article (Will He Restore Prosperity?), we referred to the fact that a series of deceitful and devious leaders will cause hyperinflation of our currency. This series will conclude with the most deceitful and dangerous one of all, the Anti-Christ (*Revelation 6:1-2*).

We also explained why hyperinflation of the currency is necessary to prepare the way for the coming of the Anti-Christ.
