## THEY MISSED A BLESSING

There were three groups of saved people living on the earth during the earthly ministry of Jesus Christ. The first group we mentioned continued to refer to themselves as disciples of John the Baptist all of their lives. The second group of saved people living on the earth during the earthly ministry of Jesus Christ had originally come to Jesus Christ and had became one of His disciples but had abandoned Him (John 6:66-69).

The third group of saved people living on the earth during the earthly ministry of Jesus Christ was His disciples that did not abandon Him. According to the apostle Paul in 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 15:1-8, there were at least 500 members of the church in Jerusalem that had not abandoned Him and therefore had the privilege of seeing Him in His resurrected body during the 40 days between His resurrection and His ascension back into Heaven.

Those who abandoned Jesus Christ missed the special blessing of companionship with Him and being instructed by Him during the 40 days between His resurrection and His ascension.
