## WHAT HAVE WE DONE?

Judas allowed Satan to become the guiding force in his life and Satan led Judas to betray Jesus Christ (Luke 22:1-5). At the time, Judas did not consider the consequences his actions would have upon Jesus Christ nor did he reckon the consequences his actions would have upon himself. All he could think about was what he had been promised and how it would give him a better life. Later, after Judas evaluated the price he would end up paying as a consequence for what he had done, he took his life. *“3 When Judas, who had betrayed him, saw that Jesus was condemned, he was seized with remorse and returned the thirty silver coins to the chief priests and the elders. 4 “I have sinned,” he said, “for I have betrayed innocent blood.” “What is that to us?” they replied. “That’s your responsibility.” 5 So Judas threw the money into the temple and left. Then he went away and hanged himself.” Matthew 27:3-5 New International Version*
